Objectives

The sharing and variations of Han Character is a unique feature among a number of Asian languages: Korean learns Hanja; Japanese learns Kanji; Chinese in Mainland China and Singapore learns simplified Hanzi while Chinese in Taiwan and Hong Kong learns traditional Hanzi. This Conference aims to bring together scholars, researchers and practitioners from different Asian countries to foster international knowledge exchanges and research collaborations on Han characters education and research. Building upon accomplishments and successes in the first five conferences, the sixth one will be held at Hangzhou, People's Republic of China, in July 2015.

Themes

- (1) Han character education: including theoretical framework, teaching and learning materials, pedagogical strategies, information technology in Han character education; classical Chinese or literary Chinese and so on.
- (2) Researches on Han character: including history of Han character, philology of Han character, theoretical framework, annotation, study of Han character etc.

Procedure of Abstract Submission

- 1) Abstract proposal should be submitted via online system for review before 10 March 2015.
- 2) Conference Organizing Committee will notify the abstract acceptance via email before 31 March 2015. Invitation letter will be sent out to accepted presenters at mid of April 2015.
- 3) Those full papers submitted by accepted presenters via email to lithongxian2011@163.com before 31 May 2015 will be included in the Conference Proceeding in CD format. Please observe the Full Paper Submission Guideline to prepare your paper. Please note that the submission of full paper is not a mandatory requirement. The paper should be your original work, except where due acknowledgement is made, and it has not been previously published.
- 4) If you need the Conference Secretariat to arrange accommodation for you, please submit the necessary information when you make online registration.

Format of Abstract

Abstract (including title and keywords) should be written in English **or** Chinese with 800 words at maximum. If it is written in other language(s), please also submit a version in English **or** Chinese. The abstract should summarize the purpose of the study, methods, major findings with evidence / examples. Please submit the abstract via online system (the link on the last page) for review by the submission deadline.

Presentation Languages

- Preferably Chinese (Mandarin) or English.
- If you use Korean to present, interpretation service (to Mandarin) will be provided at the Conference.
- For those presentations conducted in English/Korean/Japanese, the ppt (powerpoint) should have Chinese for reference. For those conducted in Chinese, the ppt should have English for reference.
